Females 10% - 17% Jail Population

State Sentenced 3% in 2012; as high as 11% - 12% (and steady) starting in 2016

Probation and Parole 6% in 2013; high of 12% in 2016; maintaining 7%-9%

County Sentenced; high of 45% in 2012; steadily declining all the way to 6% in 2021

HIP Returns 38%-66% on a given day returned to jail for no place to live
